

A Teaching Pavilion for the Student House

The idyllic mountain lodge is now also open to alumni.

Who doesn't have fond memories of the university's beautifully situated "student house" on Schauinsland? It was built on nearby Schauinsland mountain in 1933 and has since enjoyed uncontested status as the University of Freiburg's "favorite seminar room." Professors enjoy using the typical Black Forest lodge as a retreat for weekend compact seminars. When the Office of Student Services withdrew after running the student house for many years, the University of Freiburg took over the house and had it renovated. Alumni Freiburg e.V. supported this work, among other things by building its own teaching pavilion.
